



## ALCOHOL USE DISORDER (AUD) FAST FACTS: ACCESS TO TREATMENT

Less than 10% of individuals with AUD receive any treatment to help battle the disorder<sup>1</sup>



Less than 2% of individuals with AUD are prescribed FDA-approved medications

## **Medication**

There are currently three FDA-approved medications for treating AUD which have shown to be effective in reducing the desire to drink during periods of abstinence<sup>1</sup>.

## **Behavioral Treatments**

Behavioral treatment interventions are designed to help individuals recognize risky drinking and empower individuals to avoid circumstances that may trigger a relapse to heavy drinking.

## Support Groups

Mutual support groups help provide a network of support for maintaining abstinence and reducing the harm associated with heavy drinking.
